of section 29 all in Township No 4 South
of Range No 14 West containing twenty acres
more or less to gether with all and singular the tenement
improvements and appertenances thereto and thereunto
belonging, to have and to hold to the said
John Poe his heirs and assigns in fee simple for ever hereby
hierby covenant with him that said land is free from
all encumbrances and that we will and our heirs and
assigns shall forever warrant and defend the title
there to against all lawful claimes

for the consideration aforesaid as well as for other great
considerations I wife of the said John W Poe hereby sell
releases set over and assign unto the said John Poe all my
right or possibility of dower in and to said lands
