To all to whom these Presents shall come--Greeting:

Know Ye, THAT, WHEREAS, By an Ordinance of the Convention of the State of Arkansas, adopted on the 27th day of May, 1861, it was provided that DEEDS should be issued to, and in the names of all persons, who may have entered any of the Public Lands of the United States prior to the 6th day of May, 1861, not patented by the United States up to the said 27th day of May, 1861, upon the presentation and surrender of the receipt of the Receiver, or evidence of its issuance and subsequent loss, to the Auditor of Public Accounts of the State of Arkansas: And Whereas,

has filed in this office, *Revenue Receipt No 13.506*
from which it appears, that on the *13th* day
