"William Young of Southfarnham parish in the County of Essex Gent and Katherine his wife, and Robert Ransone of St Stephons parish in the County of King & Queen Gent and Francis his wife" sell Peter Richeson of Abington parish in the County of Gloucester Gent a plantation and appurtenances of 306 acres in South Farnham parish. The aforesd Wm Young and Katherine his wife and Robert Ransone and Francis his wife in right of them the sd Katherine and Francis are seized in fee of this 306 acres, adj. the Dragon Swamp at the lower end of Essex Co which was formerly the land of Edward Thomas late of Essex Co., and known as Thomas's Quarter, which land the sd Edward Thomas by his will proved 10 Nov. 1699 was given to Elizabeth Merewether, and which at her death descended to them.
