(Note: The research on Wesley Lee Smith is work that began 3 March 2001 when Mrs. Peggy WADE contacted David ROBERTS about this web page. Peggy is the gg-granddaughter of Wesley Lee Smith. The following is the research of Mrs. Peggy WADE and David G. ROBERTS - Sept 2002)

¹ **Wesley Lee SMITH**, 10th child (of 12) of **Cornelius SMITH** and **Elizabeth ROBERTS**, was born 4 Feb 1832 in what is now known as "Bailey's Prairie," Brazoria County, Texas. The boundaries of Bailey's Prairie are in general the exact boundaries of the original Cornelius Smith tract.

In 1856 Wesley, age 24, along with his brother, **Gaines Bailey SMITH** and family moved to Caldwell County, Texas. His sister Peggy and husband, Gerren HINDS, had been living in Caldwell County since 1849. Gerren's land grant with "Green DeWitt Colony" was dated 13 Apr 1825 and the majority of his land was in Caldwell County (Gonzales in 1825). Wesley's mother Betsy, sister Polly Hinds, and brothers Henry and James remained in Brazoria County. (Note: It can be proven Gaines SMITH removed to Caldwell County in 1856 and it is **assumed** Wesley did also. Wesley deeded his 214.1/2 acres in Brazoria County to J.A. Durant in 1855. Wesley is listed in the 1860 census of Caldwell County. He had been courting Sarah Ann Pendley in Gonzales County which borders Caldwell.. so the assumption of 1856 seems reasonable.)

⁵ **Wesley** married **Sarah Ann PENDLEY** 17 May 1860 in Gonzales Co, TX. Sarah was the daughter of **Reuben PENDLEY** and **Mary Ann HISAW**.

George POE was the son James R. and Lamiley POE (daughter of Ruben and Mary PENDLEY).

⁹ Moses Howell Smith is not kin to the Wesley Lee Smith clan. Mose's wife, Cynthia, died ⁴15 May 1859. His neighbor Jane E. Pendley Daniell lost her husband during the Civil War in 1862. Moses and Jane married in 1863.

¹¹ A **John F. STANCEL** is listed as a Pvt., Vol., Co I, at the Battle of San Jacinto April 21, 1836. (*Sons of the DeWitt Colony* web site) A John F. Stencil is listed in the *1840 Citizens of Texas* by Gifford White. He arrived in Texas (Mexico) about 1835 and received a "class 1" grant of 1/3 league of land in Harris Co. A class 1 grant of 1/3 league indicates he was single and his grant was unconditional. There is a Benjamin B. STANCEL, age 57, in the 1860 Gonzales Co census. This is probably the brother of John F. STANCEL. Benjamin and John are both listed as being born in North Carolina. By the 1850 census Benjamin was in Texas about 1835.

According to a Daniel researcher, John first married Jane Sharlott DANIELL, daughter of George Daniell and Sylvania Pearce, 18 May 1852 in Gonzales Co, TX. Sharlott died in childbirth. The 1860 Gonzales census reflects John had a daughter named Ellen. Daniel researcher reflects daughter Martha Ellen Stancel.
