

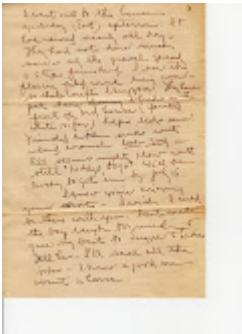
Letters from Charles Walter Henry to Esse Mae Cobb

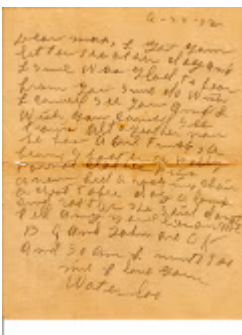

- 1) [the writer] has the 3rd page of the first letter, & it is not signed, but the handwriting looks like his & he talks about "Suggie," which was [the writer's] Aunt Inez's family nickname. He is going to tell her "a joke about a horse."
- 2) The 2nd letter is to "Mae" from "Waterloo."
- 3) The 3rd letter is romantic. He says " want you to know that I love you and always will. . . I know that you have put up with a lot ... If not for you I might have been worse . . . However, we have four beautiful children . . . Bud ([the writer's] uncle Buddy who was in a wheelchair) is a good boy if you let him have his way. The girls are like Cesar's wife." By that he means they are beyond reproach.
