Dear Mr. Walton -

Akron, Ohio who have

Do you know them? Also
we have a friend here
who has done much
research on the Watsons.
She is from the Samuel
McDowell ^{Watson} line -

I am inclosing
an affidavit from
Marvin's 90 yr. old Auntie
As you can see she is
the daughter of John a -
Hogue - Marvin's father
was James Harvey Hogue

you will notice our
dates on Sarah Templeton
Watson Hogue are not
the same - date of birth
could be accounted for
I'm sure - I have seen
the Bible record but
do not remember whether
the zero ~~for~~^{was} clear or
not. The date of death
is something else - Aunt
Ellen has told us about
her grandmother several
times. Is your date from
a Bible? - maybe Aunt
Ellen was remembering
picking cotton.
Aunt Ellen has

a younger sister living
who does not remember
her grandmother but
does remember that
there was a marker
for her grave at one
time.

Niriam Hague (from
Aunt Ellen and Aunt
Mary) visited them in
Texas and they called
him Uncle so I feel he
probably was Ezekiel
Hague's brother.

Aunt Ellen told me
the last time we went
to see her that Ann
Hague married a Holman
and she wrote to one of

the boys when she was
about 15 yrs. old - I made
a note of his name but
can't find it at the moment.
She also said one or
two of the Holman boys
studied medicine - Is
that true?

We have a big question.
Samuel McDowell Watson
married a Lucretia Hogue
in S. car. - She was the
right age to be the sister
of Ezekiel Hogue but we
have found no one who
knows - I wonder if
you have any information
on this - This would make
the Hogue-Watson line
closer, of course -

I have some Watson
information if you
do not - I'll copy for
you in the near future.
Also have the Swafford
but thought the name
was Elisbeth P. instead
of T. Maybe she was
named Templeton too.
We have nothing on
Nancy but do have Samuel
Newton's family - nothing
on any other except
John a -

We have lived here
only a short time - After
living in Okla City
for nearly 20 yrs we
have moved about 10 mi

out of town on a farm,
we had to build a home
and there are so many
things to do that we
are swamped. I teach
in the city so you see
my problem - But as
soon as I hear from
you again to know what
you want that we have
I'll get everything together
~~for~~ you -
