1. On the map of Newtonville, Ala. you listed John Reynolds, whose children married John Poe's children. Did John Reynolds live near John Poe and have you found a will for him?

Burn checked the range, township, and section on John D. Reynolds land. it was 1 mile from John Poe. One quarter mile inside Fayette Co. joining Burn's grandfather Shephard's land.

In checking my index to Fayette Co deeds, (which I copied about 2 yrs ago, of just a few people that I thought I might be interested in) I find "John & Sarah Poe of Tuscaloosa Co. in 1837 sold Benj. Reynolds of Fayette Co. 60 acres of land in Tuscaloosa Co.", signed Jno Poe
Sarah X Poe
her mark

Also, Evan B. Street owned land near Hogan's Gap and Michael Wright in Newtonville in 1838

I believe this would be a brother of Sarah Street or nephew. (See other side for Census record)

Also a Evans A. Poe owned land in 1856 near Newtonville. he was probably a descendant of John and Sarah Poe.

From Bio of James T. Poe -

1. Calvin Poe states in Goodspeed that his father was John Poe, born in Va. He assumes, but cannot prove, that my grandfather, Simon Poe, born a. 1812 and Calvin Poe were brothers. (We found our Simon Poe listed on Tax books here as Simon W.)

Your Simon B. 1812 is listed on Tuscaloosa Co. deeds as Simon C. Poe. When things are copied several times mistakes are made.

2. The John Poe listed in 1820 Census of Anson County, N.C. was probably the John Poe who married Sarah Threat. You mention that he was selling land in Anson County about 1820. If you have an opportunity to examine these deeds see if his wife Sarah appears on the deeds.

I'm mailing you a copy of what I copied on the Poe deeds.

You mentioned that you found the Settlement of Estate of Charles Holliman in 1849 - Charles D. 1844 - your gg. grandfather Hogan Derby was admin. If you mentioned checking records in Fayette Co. Do you remember if the will listed any children as heirs.

I just noticed the heading of the Settlement of the Chas. Holliman estate, because my gg grandfather's name was on it. But did not read it.

In the same letter you mentioned a will of Turner Street. This could be Sarah Street's father. If you have time will appreciate your checking. I have found no proof that Turner Street Will, April 23, 1889 ^{Sarah Street} father came to all heirs; wife Manneria S.
