Dear Mrs. Benson:


You wrote to my father, the late Capt. Cobb on Sept. 2, 1938, and I am sorry I have not answered your letter sooner. My father died on October 29, 1931.

It is with the deepest regret that I report to you that my father history of the Cobb family was not completed. However I find among his papers a copy of a letter from W. D. Cobb, which I am enclosing, and hope you will return. I am sorry I cannot give you more definite information to your line of the family.

In application for membership to the ~~AMERICAN~~ Sons of the American Revolution my ffather traced his line from Henry Cobb who saw service in the American Revolution in South Carolina. He was the father of William Cobb, who was the father of Henry B. Cobb, who was the father of John Cobb who was my grandfather.
