On June 14, 1967 Margaret Poe fell in the bathroom ~~an~~ of her
residence and broke her hip. She was taken to St. Vincent's Infirm-
ary where she was operated on by Dr. Horace Murphy who put a steel
ball in her hip. She remained in the hospital until July 8th where

she was removed to Memorial Hospital in North Little Rock, Ark. for therapy. Due to her mental confusion, she could not co-operate with the therapist. Due to her condition, she had to be moved to a nursing home. We chose Whippoorwill Park Nursing Home because of the convenience to our home.

Since her son is physically and financially unable to care for her due to his heart condition, we are asking for old age assistance for her.
