Johnston County Nov. Term 1812

First I give & bequeath to Sarah my dearly beloved wife all that part of my Estate that no exists in the State of NoCarolina & Johnston County at the present place of my residence which I received with or acquired by or in virture of my marriage with said Sarah. Consisting of personal property, viz,

Also, I give to my daughter Mary and William Hunt. Three hundred dollars ...to be raised and levied out of my Estate.

Also I give to my grandchildren the orphans of my Son John Carrell dec. Two hundred dollars cash to be equally divided amongst them when they come of age.

Also I give to the Lawful.....of my son Mitchel Carrell & Sarah his wife.....

Also, I give to my son James Carrell.....

Also, I give to my son Wm Carrell.....

Also I give to the said William Carrell & James jointly all and singular my land

Also I likewise constitue and make the said William Carrell the sole Executor of this my last will and testament.....
