- 2 William (2) b 1800 m 2-9-1823 Ann "the Quakeress"
 was James being William (1) - known b 1809 George b 1822 Joseph b 1835 - blind at 14
- (?) (3) had 72-11 Ezekiel mentioned in Friends Families of Upper South
 by Robertus probably the 2nd son of Solomon which is
 not correct and probably also a son of William (4) brother
 an extensive search had family records

 had 12 children & Texas 1837
- 5 Rev Ezekiel (5) b NC 1-6-1794 to SC 1820 to Tenn 1831 P. O. b 1837 to Tenn 1846
 m in Templeton (Watson) the only daughter of
 Houghton Watson - who was son of Col Edward Watson
- 6 Samuel Newton (6) b 11-4-1803 Tenn to TX 1849 to Texas 1849
 m Susan E. Tull & Co Texas
- 7 James Archibald (7) b 7-11-1814 Tenn to Texas 1844 m Mary
 m Mary E. Pease & Co Texas
- 8 Ernest Newton (8) b 4-6-1819 Tenn to Texas 1844 to Texas 1844
 to Washington the Capt. CAPT. 1844 to TX 1849
 was 1st & 2nd in Pease & Co Texas

Solomon's son William (4) "The Family of Hoge",
by James Hoge Tyler, was about the right one to
have been our William (4).

Solomon in the "Hoge" line had another
family name Hovey (Hawley) which is also a
family name in our line.

When our William (4) went to SC he had John,
James, and Daniel also went with him.

Our William (4) had sons Ezekiel, Lewis,
Benjamin, Hiram, Edward, Henry and others.
Three sons and one daughter born before
1800 or so. The wife of William (4) was Nancy,
a family name so used on some to the present
generation.
