Dear Winfred:

I went to the Hist. Library about noon yesterday and copied what you'll see on the other sheet of paper because I didn't have scratch paper handy. The Librarian said this list of film was far from being complete. There was too much to copy. The state also has a lot of film which is different from the list enclosed. Hoping you'll excuse being so messy.

A Mrs. Miller here in Okla. City, told me about Mr. Charles Bennett being a wealthy person and is not interested in Genealogy but enjoys going through the records. Does it for free. DO NOT QUOTE ME. But send a self addressed envelope and 1 name at a time. He has about 10,000 grave markers East Tenn. on file. Just say Mrs. Miller referred you to him. Mr. Charles Bennett owns the Chester Inn in Jonesboro, Tenn.

Just started 1850 Census of Chatham Co. N.C. today when Mrs. Miller came in and got the Alabama Genealogical Society Registrar magazines on hand for me. I spent a good 3 hours looking. Had many of Petete, Hallingworth, Windle, Shepherd, Williams, Jones info. These are relatives on mothers side in Pickens Co. Ala. Also Clardy, Sutton, Cockrell, Duren, House. Doc. They Theo. S. Petete came to Reform Ala. about 1840 + Clardy + Hallingworth and they are still here today. A few left. So most everyone in Pickens County is a relative of mine. There are some in Lamar Co. and a few in Tuscaloosa and Morgan Co.

Boy howdy it rough to get any info. out of them. But all of my info. came from one 2nd cousin there and my uncle Charlie Petite in Haddenville, Ocala. If you ever see a Cockrell from there ask him for info. for me.

Wednesday came home from work and lighted the fire for the 1st time since spring, then went outside to dry grass roots. Come in about 20 minutes to make coffee and the living room was filled with smoke. The divan was on fire underneath. Burned the rug also. Got the thing outside and put out. To-day the adjuster came. So will be ok. I live 6 miles South 1/4 East of Edmond or 6 miles east of Britton. So a serious fire would destroy all I had so have to be insured. My telephone number is VI 2-2962 and is not listed in the book here.

Should I stay in line on days off I should get a Sat. Sun. Monday off about Xmas & January? You see I will have 4 weeks Thursdays & Fridays off. Then jump ahead 1 day which will be Friday & Sat off. So when I go to Sat & Sundays I will or should get the 3 days off. But so far I have been put back each time. Anyway when the 3 days off comes around I will come to Benton on L.R. So will miss one days work and we should have a nice visit. Somehow will go to L.R. and am sure you can get some Poe info. Don't know the peoples names or would write them. Have forgotten. They were neighbors to Aunt Alice Sullivan for years. Hope Jerry my son will be able to come with me. For some reason his mother is sore at me, won't let him visit me.

I am as interested in the Poe line as you I hope. But should get a ans. from the Julia D.A.R. on this line soon.

Will close.

P.S. All the people I know Ans. when you can. John C. ask me how I'm doing the mail Wednesday. rec'd. the Poe names in the mail Wednesday.
